#### Grants

- Submitted grants to Richard M. Schulze Family Foundation, RBC Wealth Management and Xcel Energy Foundation
- Conducted site visit with Schulze Foundation
- Conducted site visit with Xcel Energy Foundation at Totino-Grace. Thanks to Greg Chamberlain for participating and supporting our efforts.
- Received \$171,000 in grant funding from the 3M Foundation which will be reflected in February
- Received \$25,000 from the General Mills Foundation
- Plan to approach the St. Paul Foundation's Management Improvement Fund to ask for a grant to cover the remaining costs of SCOPE as well as an additional funding towards marketing the study
- Have submitted an LOI to Kern Family Foundation for our STEM program. They were identified through our new Foundation Search service. Additional prospects will be provided in the June board report
