We are proud to share the 2021-22 Annual Report with donors, members, and advocates of MINNDEPENDENT. Thank you for sharing your time, talent, and financial resources in our mission of connecting and supporting private and independent schools in Minnesota.

The past year was highlighted by the full transition to the new organizational name and brand. This transition has been well received including a response from a member school, "I love the new name and logo!!! This looks like a very smart and well considered rebrand. It's refreshing to have an educational organization whose name cannot be reduced to yet another acronym!"

Further highlights during the past fiscal year include:

- Membership grew 7.5% to the organization's highest membership of 172 members schools
- Retention of member schools hit an all-time high of 98%
- Surpassed more than \$1.5 million in STEM grants and program assistance to member schools since 2009
- Continued to build further financial stability through thoughtful partnership and long-term reserves

These points of emphasis further illustrate the important place MINNDEPENDENT plays in the private and independent school community. Schools across Minnesota trust MINNDEPENDENT to provide critical information, thoughtful programming, a unified voice, and guidance in a timely and accurate manner.

As we look forward, the board of directors will begin charting the future of MINNDEPENDENT. The organization will engage in a thorough process to meet the needs of our vital educational sector. 




