Schools that applied and were approved for the most recent round of Emergency Assistance to Nonpublic Schools (EANS 3) should have received notification on Friday regarding the process and eligible expense areas. The eligible categories are listed below, and include an additional sixth area of service. We are grateful to the Minnesota Department of Education for this additional activity. MINNDEPENDENT, fellow nonpublic education partners and several schools advocated to have this additional eligible activity included.

Below are the activities for which these funds may be used:

- Mental health services to address the effects of the COVID 19 pandemic
- Professional development to assist staff in addressing the effects of the COVID 19 pandemic
- Partnerships with college education departments to develop educator training programs
- Counseling of K-6 grades to address the effects of the COVID 19 pandemic
- Resources to help nonpublic schools further research test and/or assessment data in regard to the COVID 19 pandemic and its effect on students' learning recovery
- Initiating and maintaining education and support services or assistance for remote or hybrid learning or to address learning recovery

The 2023 legislative session begins on January 3, 2023. With redistricting and legislators retirements, nearly one-third of all legislators will be new to their respective roles. MINNDEPENDENT looks forward to meeting with committee chairs and legislators to ensure the voice and interests of private and independent schools are heard and valued.
