

# MEMBERSHIP


**HOSA membership is available to students in

**\*HOSA members are responsible for following the four core values of HOSA; Learn, Lead, Serve, and Innovate.**


**HOSA members are respectful and respected; role models; value service; prepared and knowledgeable; compassionate leaders and forward thinkers.**
